



**Power 2 Play Sports Event Center  
Tournament and League Play Overview for visitors**

**Please review, as you will see and experience all while visiting our league and tournament play.**

*\*updated July 16, 2020, 1:00 pm*

*Per Colorado Governor Polis, we are now in a “mandated” mask wearing requirement for all people entering businesses. All people are required to wear a mask entering the Event Center for tournament and league play.*

*Power 2 Play Sports has provided masks for those who do not have one while visiting, and available at the entry way upon entering.*

***Per Larimer County Health Department Inspection 7/18, 1:30 pm***

*Players, coaches, and officials must wear their masks entering the building until they get to the bench. They are allowed to participate in the game without a mask until the game is over. Once the game is over, they must put mask back on as they enter the building. If at any time they leave the bench to go to the restroom, approach a parent/family member, they must wear their mask.*

*No bleacher seating will be available. They have been removed and spectators are limited. Those allowed to enter will bring their own seating, and must sit on the X marked areas on the floor to ensure social distancing.*

*Announcements are made throughout the events to serve as a reminder for social distancing and wearing masks.*

*Thank you for following this order.*

Prior to arriving at the Event Center, all spectators, players, officials, and coaches are required to:

1. Complete an online questionnaire and COVID screening questionnaire.
2. Reminded to wear a mask to the event.
3. Spectators are limited and must purchase admissions pass online to organize personal information for tracing and who is attending the event.

When arriving to the event.

1. Wear your mask.
2. P2P Sports will provide a mask for all not having a mask as they enter the Event Center.
3. No one is allowed in the main entrance. All must enter the Event Center in doors 1, 3, 4, and 6.
4. Teams/coaches enter together and leave together after each game.

- X marks the spot in the sports lounge, hallways, bathrooms, food courts, as a “reminder” of social distancing.
- No outside equipment or balls are allowed in the Event Center.
- X marks the spot bleachers for “reminder” of social distancing/seating.
- Doors are not entered until the horn sounds for each game, each court.
- All teams exit from the courts into the sports lounge and restrooms, and 5 minutes maximum to do both and exit the building.
- Once teams have left the courts, the doors on east and west will open inviting the next group of teams to begin warmups.
- Once the games begin, the east and west doors are locked with no one allowed in the building. Those who arrive late must check in main entrance outside for approval to enter the event.
- Supervisors on east and west wings will assist in traffic flow, wiping balls, cleaning.
- Sports lounge supervisor will direct traffic flow out of the building.
- Sanitizer throughout the building.
- All coaches, players, and parents have completed online waiver and questionnaire as friendly reminder of social distancing, stay home if you are ill/sick, and respectful conduct.

- Spectator admission sold in advance. When we are sold out, they are sold out and no additional tickets or exceptions can be made. Those unable to attend provided Pay Per View Viewing on Live-Stream.
- Staff wearing masks.
- Regular hourly cleaning, and all equipment on courts are cleaned before, at ½ time and after games.
- No post-game handshakes will take place.
- 4.5 acres available for teams to wait before, between and after games, while social distancing being priority.

Outdoor amenities of north and south patio, east and south lawn, and lake area seating is available with adequate space for social distancing, and enjoying before, between and after games.

Athletic trainer is provided. A separate room is provided for trainer. They are required to wear a mask. All spectators entering the room must wear a mask.
